BNSF Agricultural Products 2009 Labor Day Operating Plan

HOLIDAY OBSERVANCE

This year, the Labor Day holiday will be observed on **Monday, September 7**.

TRAIN SERVICE

BNSF's Agricultural Products 2009 Labor Day Operating Plan will focus on meeting customers' expectations while matching operations to anticipated reductions in traffic volumes.

Trains will operate normally on Sunday, September 6. To the extent possible, BNSF plans to minimize the number of yard, local, and road-switch assignments at terminals on Monday, September 7, resuming normal operations at 6:30 a.m. on Tuesday, September 8.

Throughout the holiday weekend, BNSF may annul or consolidate trains in line with anticipated reduced traffic volumes. Unit trains--both loaded and empty--will operate as per customer requirement.

INTERLINE TRAFFIC

Delays may occur on interline traffic if connecting carriers have reduced operations for the holiday.
