



2025 Technology Awareness Day Essay Contest Rules

SPONSOR

Sponsor is BNSF Railway ("Sponsor" or "BNSF").

TERM

The 2025 BNSF Railway's Technology Awareness Day Essay Contest ("Contest") ends on January 31st, 2025.

Financial Aid contest registration should be completed at the time registration for the event is submitted by the student participant but is not required to participate.

Completed entries must be received no later than **January 31, 2025**. **Entries received after this date will not be considered.**

Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these official rules ("Official Rules"). By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees to the Official Rules and warrants that his or her entry complies with all requirements set out in the Official Rules. This is a skill-based contest and chance plays no part in the determination of winners.

WHO MAY ENTER?

Eligibility:

The contest is open only to students at participating schools or programs who are in 9th through 12th grades at the time of entry.

One contest entry, per category submission, per student. There is no cost to enter the contest.

As of 2024, Past Grand Prize Winners are now eligible to participate in the category they won.

CONTEST RULES:

The essay must be:

- Based on the prompt listed below
- An original, unpublished work. Essays deemed not original work will be disqualified.
- Include a cover page with student's name, school, program, and grade
- Word Count for 9th/10th graders: At least 350 words
- Word Count for 11th/12th graders: At least 500 words
- Double-spaced, 12-point font
- Bibliography is **not** included in the word count
- Contestants should proofread entries for spelling and grammar errors.
- Participant can attend TAD either virtually or in person to qualify for the contest

Regarding sources:

- It is recommended that you support your arguments with qualified sources.



- Use direct quotes when taking a source word for word. Use MLA style in-text citations and bibliography entries.
- Don't focus on strict adherence to MLA – the important thing is that we know which parts of your essay are from an outside source, and where we can find that source.

Contestants will be competing in one of two groups: 9/10th graders and 11/12th graders. The top three contestants from each group will be recognized and awarded prizes on **February 8, 2025**. Prizes in past years typically included laptops and tablets.

PROMPT

Authenticity in AI

Authenticity in AI means making sure that the artificial intelligence system behaves in a way that is fair, honest, and follows ethical standards. This involves using unbiased data to train the AI, being transparent about how decisions are made, and protecting user privacy. Authenticity in AI also calls for maintaining ethical standards and protecting user data. By prioritizing authenticity in AI development and implementation, we can help ensure that these systems benefit society in positive ways and align with our shared values and goals.

JUDGING CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS

Judges will select the top entries by applying the following criteria (“Judging Criteria”):

- a) Style and Mechanics (grammar, sentence structure, etc.) (15%)
- b) Quality of work (15%)
- c) Originality (20%)
- d) Creative Expression (20%)
- e) Adherence to Theme (30%)

Decisions of the Judges are final.
